Congratulations to our President and Founder, Stephanie. She is soon to be a self-published children's book author.

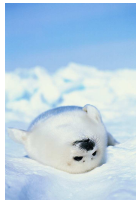
An inspiring children's book, *Sydney Saves a Species, The Power*
